Each year, in conjunction with the Pennsylvania Game Commission, Central Columbia School District offers a hunter safety education course. This course will be offered at no cost to Central Columbia students. Students must be eleven years old by the first day of this course.

The hunter safety course will be taught by Mr. Curt Turner, a certified instructor, in the High School Auditorium. All materials will be supplied by the Pennsylvania Game Commission. It is encouraged by the PA Game Commission that all students access the following website to read and study Chapters 1,4,5,9 (33 pages total) of the Today's Hunter and Trapper in Pennsylvania student education manual **prior to the beginning of class.**

Students may also choose to read the above chapters and information from the pdf file "Today's Hunter & Trapper in PA" in e-backpack found in the Hunter Safety 2019 class folder. This will only be available to students after they join the class in e-backpack on the March 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> registration day.

Students **must attend all classes** which are scheduled from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday, March 11<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday March 12, 2019. The testing day will be Tuesday March 12<sup>th</sup>. No classes will be held if school is closed or dismissed early due to weather conditions. (Wednesday, March 13, 2019, will be scheduled as a make up day if there are weather related issues.) Transportation home after the course is the responsibility of parents/guardians. **All students must know their entire mailing address (including zip code), phone number, and birthdate. If needed, a student should have a written copy containing this information for the first day of this course.**
