

# Central Columbia Middle School

## OPTIONS FOR REOPENING OUR SCHOOL



### Face to Face

Instruction is delivered in person. In this setting, students will attend our brick and mortar school with safety guidelines put in place.

### Remote (Virtual) Learning

Instruction will occur with Central Columbia teachers utilizing the curriculum developed by our district and board approved. Students in this setting will work from home. Instruction will be delivered on a consistent daily schedule with our face to face model. Daily and period attendance will be required. This model offers the closest option to being in our brick and mortar school without being there.

### Online Learning Academy

This is a cyber option. Curriculum and instruction are provided by our vendor Edgenuity. Courses are monitored by Edgenuity's teachers including support services.

### Face to Face

#### Prior to School

For the safety of all, check students for symptoms of COVID-19 every morning.

Parents are encouraged to keep students at home if any symptoms are present.

#### Transportation And Arrival

Masks are required while boarding, riding, and getting off the bus. Students from the same household will be expected to sit together. Buses will be cleaned on a daily basis.

All student's temperatures will be taken prior to entering the school building.

#### The Classroom

Upon entering the building, students will go directly to homeroom or breakfast.

Classrooms and common areas will be set up to social distance to the greatest extent possible.

Signs are posted in classrooms and common areas promoting safe habits such as safe social distancing, hand washing, germ spread prevention, and proper use of masks.

High traffic and high touch surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized regularly throughout the school day. All classrooms and common areas will be cleaned and sanitized every day.

Frequent masks breaks will be incorporated into the school day.

Hallway travel will follow prescribed routes.

In order to adhere to social distancing guidelines, we will be unable to permit the use of lockers.

Shared materials and group work will be minimized.

Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be available in every classroom.

Hand washing stations are accessible in every classroom.

Desks will be sanitized daily, and rooms will be sprayed each evening.

#### CAT Classes

Students need to wear sneakers and appropriate attire on PE days for activities.

Locker rooms will not be utilized during the school day.

Band lessons and choral ensembles will occur within small groups maximizing student safety.



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION DUE TO THE IMPACT OF COVID

Parents and students are advised that any destination determined by the Pennsylvania Department of Health at the time of your trip require a period of quarantine upon return to Pennsylvania will require the student to attend school via our Remote Learning option for a period not to exceed 14 days before the student can return to our school for face-to-face instruction.

### **Cafeteria**

Hand sanitizer will be available for use at the cafeteria entrance.

Students will follow a one-way traffic pattern and tables will be limited to three students.

Once seated students can remove masks, providing an opportunity for conversation.

Tables will be cleaned and sanitized in-between lunches.

Lunches will be individually packaged.

### **Nurse's Office Plan**

Chairs in the waiting area will be socially distanced to the greatest extent possible.

In the event a student exhibits symptoms of COVID-19, the student will be isolated in the Nurses's suite.

After being notified, a parent or guardian must pick their student up as soon as possible.

### **Exiting the School Building**

At the end of the school day, students will be expected to exit the building and go to their bus or vehicle immediately. Plans are being made to make sure that dismissal is structured for safety.

### **Additional Precautions**

Students and staff will wear face masks at all times.

Every student will receive a washable mask provided by the school district. Parents and guardians can provide protective gear for their students as well.

Floor markers will be used to show the flow of traffic in the hallways, and decals will be used to identify seats that may be used in larger shared spaces.

Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building.

## **Virtual Instruction**

Students will receive all instruction and assessments virtually at home.

Central Columbia School District curriculum taught by Central Columbia teachers.

Access to all CCSD curriculum, activities, events, and programs.

Use of district-provided device.

Instruction delivered on a consistent daily schedule.

Daily and period attendance required.

Provides for a smoother transition back to face to face learning.

Two-week minimum enrollment.

## **Online Learning Academy**

All courses are taught through the online vendor Edgenuity.

Edgenuity's courses, curriculum, and teachers.

Access to all CCSD extra-curricular activities, co-curricular activities, events, and programs.

Use of district-provided device or home device.

A daily schedule will be followed.
